## “The Journey of Lent: A Gift of Anticipation”

March 26-27, 2004 • Lenten Retreat

Participants will have an opportunity during the season of lent to participate in worship, guided meditations, reflection, the labyrinth, stations of the cross and workshops in expectation of meeting Jesus in renewal of life and the resurrection of Easter.

**The Rev. Bee Billups** is a non-parochial priest in the Diocese of Maryland. She serves as a spiritual director, consultant, retreat leader and designer. In addition to serving as Chaplain, Bee will give the Friday keynote address on **The Anticipation of Lent: A Teaching**.

### Journey of Lent Workshops

**Icons: Windows on the Divine** – Icons are objects of art intended to lead us into a life of prayer. Discover how icons draw and invite us to share in a reality far wider than our human relationships and deeper than our keenest insights. The space between the icon and the beholder is alive with the spirit of the Living God. **The Rt. Rev. Robert Ihloff**

**Brendan the Navigator: An invitation to Adventure** - St. Brendan was a 6th century Celtic saint who sailed in a small hide-covered boat from Ireland to the new world and back. Through prayer and the study of his adventure explore how God may be asking us to enter the risky adventure of the spiritual life. Workshop leader **Debra Donnelly Barton** will also lead a meditation on the Journey of the Labyrinth on Friday.

**Wrapped in God: Prayer and Prayer Shawls** – Make (stitch, paint, or stencil) prayer shawls for private devotions or meditation. Workshop leader is **Madeleine Beard**.

**Centering Prayer: A Method** – An introduction to a method of prayer designed to facilitate Contemplative Prayer – opening oneself to a closer relationship with God. Workshop leader is **The Rev. John Smith**.

**Rosary Making and History** – Opportunity to make a rosary and learn about this tradition of prayer. Workshop leader is **The Rev. Kerry Smith**.

**Using the Rosary in Contemplative Prayer** – An introduction to the Anglican Rosary as a tool for contemplative prayer and how to use the rosary in private and communal prayer. Workshop leader is **The Rev. Kerry Smith**.

## “Creator God: Artist in Residence”

June 25-27, 2004 • Faith & Arts Retreat

Participants will look at inspiration for art as an expression of the artist's faith and seek ways that God creates through us. All of us create and no special experience or abilities are required. There will be large blocks of time with staff and fellow Christians to explore and reflect on art. In addition to work and reflection sessions there will be special worship and fellowship time. Early summer at Claggett will provide outside opportunities in a beautiful setting.

**Drawing & Painting**—Two extended blocks of time on Saturday morning and afternoon will provide participants the opportunity to explore faith through drawing and painting. Workshop leaders are **Barbara Barrett and Pat McHold**.

**Dance & Movement**—Participants will experience faith through dance and movement with Wendy and Janice in morning and afternoon sessions. Workshop leaders are **The Rev. Janice Gordon-Barnes and Wendy Walker**.

**Literature & Personal Reflection**—On Saturday morning participants will explore a short story in a different way, not just looking into it as an integrated work of literature and an expression of the author's faith, but also through it to see the ways it reveals each workshop participant's own faith. Participants will have the opportunity to write and share their own reflections. Workshop leader is **Menalcus Lankford**.

One Saturday afternoon workshop will focus on the use of figurative language (word pictures), the stock-in-trade of poetry, to express spiritual insight. The group will then discuss several recent poems which explore faith-related issues and will ask how such poems can be used to articulate faith and build community. Workshop Leader is **The Rev. Ben Smith**.

A second Saturday afternoon workshop will explore selections from the English devotional poetry of the seventeenth century (Donne, Herbert, Crashaw and Vaughn) to come to an understanding and an evaluation of their approach to the spiritual. Workshop leader is **Jim Galbraith**.
